RESOLUTION 08-03-52-99

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MUTUAL NON-INTERFERENCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PUEBLO OF LAGUNA AND THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is the legislative body of the Band, acting under Band law; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Band Assembly hereby approves the mutual Non-Interference Agreement between the Pueblo of Laguna and the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a of legislators being quorum present held on the 16th of March at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
