## **RESOLUTION 08-02-19-99**

## A RESOLUTION TERMINATING A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, agricultural and seasonal recreational residence, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and:
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Tract #410T11

Lot 14, Water and Sewer Map, within the East half of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (E1/2NW1/4NW1/4NW1/4) of Section 28, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, 4<sup>th</sup> PM, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota.

Cancellation requested by Lessor due to non-use of the site. Request for use by another Mille Lacs Band Member pending.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminates (Resolution 8-81) this land lease effective December 4, 1998.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 4th day of December 1998 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT</u>.
