## **RESOLUTION 08-03-54-99**

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PLACE LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe a federally recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have acquired land within the exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation for housing, agricultural, and public purposes; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to have these lands transferred to the United States of America in Trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be transferred to the United States of America in Trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe;

Real property located in Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, known as Tract #410 TF 95 described as follows:

The East Half of the Southwest Quarter (E½ of SW¼) and the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ of SW¼) all in Section Thirty (30), Township Forty-three (43), Range Twenty-seven (27). (Keller)

- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 30th day of March, 1999 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
