RESOLUTION 08-03-77-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RELINQUISHMENT FROM THE
LAC COURTE ORELLES RESERVATION TO THE MILLE LACS BAND,
MILLE LACS RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following applications for relinquishment from the Lac Courtes Oreilles Reservation; and,

have signed a relinquishment form with the Lac Courte Oreilles Reservation and relinquish and surrender any and all rights, title and interest that they may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Lac Courte Oreilles Reservation; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does determine that these relinquishments are proper and that the interest of the individuals have been considered and that these individuals do meet the requirements for membership with the Mille Lacs Band and does approve the granting of the relinquishments for the above individuals.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of July, 1999 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.


