RESOLUTION 08-02-17-99

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, agricultural and seasonal recreational residence, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Parcel A of Central Minnesota Survey Map dated 10/13/98, and Job #985943

That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 7, thence North 89 degrees 37 minutes, 27 seconds East, assumed bearing 447.41 feet along the South line of said Southwest Quarter, thence North 0 degrees 22 minutes 33 seconds West 51.87 feet to a point on the Northerly right of way line of County Road No. 25, the point of beginning of the tract of land to be described; thence North 14 degrees 29 minutes 37 seconds West 239.79 feet; thence North 75 degrees 30 minutes 23 seconds East 150.00 feet; thence South 14 degrees 29 minutes 37 seconds East 250.87 feet to the Northerly right of way line of County Road No. 25; thence Southwesterly 150.43 feet along said right of way line to the point of beginning, excepting therefrom the gravel Pit Road, as indicated on aforementioned survey map, which Lessee may use as access to and from homesite only.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years and renewable for 25 years subject to the lease provisions effective December 4, 1998; and,

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the lessee will utilize the land in conformity with the provisions of the lease within twelve (12) months, if all terms of the lease are not met, the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lessee abandon or vacate the above-described property for more than thirty (30) consecutive days without the prior approval of the Band Assembly; and,
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINANLLY RESOLVED, that this will terminate any other residential lease agreement that may be in existence.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a of legislators being quorum present held on the 4th day of December, 1998 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
