A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFER OF ENROLLMENT TO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FROM BAD RIVER RESERVATION.


- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following application for transfer from the Bad River to Mille Lacs; and,
- WHEREAS, the following individual is eligible due to their blood quantum and their ancestral background:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly accepts the above individual for enrollment and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required transfer.
