RESOLUTION 08-04-15-00

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING TO CHANGE ROAD DESIGNS FROM METRIC UNITS TO STANDARD ENGLISH UNITS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have contracted under the provisions of the P.L. 93-638 to conduct transportation planning activities; and,
- WHEREAS, in order to identify and more effectively identify the transportation needs of the Reservation by using standard English units over the metric system.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly do hereby direct the Bureau to change from metric units to standard English units as the measuring system for all future BIA road design and maintenance.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th day of January, 2000 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
