A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT TO DEVELOP THE CURRICULUM, EVENTS, AND ACTIVITIES FOR THE MISIZAAGAIGANII- ANISHINAABE IZHITWAAWIN CAMP (MILLE LACS OJIBWE TRADITIONS- A LANGUAGE AND CULTURAL IMMERSION CAMP).

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly wishes to create an Ojibwe Culture and Language Camp to preserve the history, customs, values and language of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe which was identified in the Band's Strategic Plan; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly believes the Band should pursue funding from the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) to develop the curriculum and activities for this Camp; and,
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves application to the (ANA) for this purpose.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24th day of January, 2000 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of \_3\_FOR,\_0\_AGAINST,\_0\_SILENT.
