## RESOLUTION 09-01-29-00

A RESOLUTION DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO DETERMINE MEMBERSHIP FOR PURPOSES OF IMPLEMENTING THE INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, since the earliest days of our existence, and well prior to the time of federal recognition, the Mille Lacs Band determined it's own membership, and
- WHEREAS, as an attribute of it's inherent sovereign authority the Mille Lacs Band continues to regulate its internal and social relationships, including determining which persons are considered members of the Mille Lacs Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is a signatory to the Tribal/State Agreement with the State of Minnesota, said Agreement includes the policies and procedures encompassed in the comprehensive working relationship which is utilized when children of any of the eleven (11) Tribes in Minnesota are involved in State Court proceedings involving the Indian Child Welfare Act; said Agreement provides that "A decision by the Indian Child's Tribe that states the child is a member of said Tribe is conclusive"; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has delegated its membership determinations for purposes of implementing the Indian Child Welfare Act to the Mille Lacs Band Director of Tribal Operations; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band's membership determinations have uniformly been recognized as an exercise of the fundamental attribute of Tribal Sovereignty to determine its own membership and the Band's determinations have never been challenged in the past; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby officially delegate authority to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe's Director of Tribal Operations to determine membership of children in the Mille Lacs Band for purposes of the Indian Child Welfare Act.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all children who have one or more ancestors who were enrolled or eligible for enrollment on the Mille Lacs Reservation, shall, for purposes of the Indian Child Welfare Act, be considered members of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
