RESOLUTION 09-02-95-00

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION #08-01-109-98,
AMENDED BY RESOLUTION #08-02-26-99**

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,
- WHEREAS, Resolution #08-01-109-98, amended by Resolution #08-02-26-99, authorized a lease to be given to [REDACTED] and,
- WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

That part of Government Lot 3, Section 23, Township 49 North, Range 23 West, Aitkin County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 32; thence South 2 degrees 16 minutes 39 seconds East, assumed bearing, 1511.02 feet along the East line of said Section 32; thence south 87 degrees 43 minutes 21 seconds West 546.92 feet to the centerline of County Road No. 6, the point of beginning of said tract to be described; thence Southwesterly along said centerline of County Road No. 6, along a curve concave to the West, having a radius of 1308.62 feet, an arc length of 33.27 feet and whose chord bears South 36 degrees 04 minutes 04 seconds West 33.27 feet; thence continuing along said centerline of County Road No. 6 South 37 degrees 08 minutes 33 seconds West 167.81 feet; thence South 58 degrees 58 minutes 37 seconds East 145 feet, more or less, to the shoreline of Mud Lake; thence Easterly and Northeasterly along said shoreline of Mud Lake 348 feet, more or less, to its intersection with a line which bears South 58 degrees 58 minutes 37 seconds East from the point of beginning; thence North 58 degrees 58 minutes 37 seconds West 404 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Subject to County Road No. 6 across the westerly 70 feet thereof.

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

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Cancellation of Land Use Agreement for the lease authorized by Band Resolution #08-01-109-98 and amended by Resolution #08-02-26-99; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 26th of September, 2000 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
