RESOLUTION 09-01-25-00

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE BAND OF OJIBWE SUPPORTING THE CULTURAL ACTIVITIES PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is to identify the Cultural Activities Project pertinent to the jurisdictions of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is desirous in obtaining funding for the project from the National Park Service.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe prepare an application and proposal to fund this worthwhile project.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Natural Resources are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Chief Executive hereunto cause to have set my signature to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
