RESOLUTION 09-01-39-00

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ASSIGNMENT OF
RESIDENTIAL LEASE ISSUED TO [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] RESOLUTION #07-04-11-98**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a homesite or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution #07-04-11-98 authorized a land lease to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years and renewable for 25 years subject to the lease provisions effective November 14, 1997; and,

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has submitted a written request to have his lease assigned to his father, [REDACTED] as his residence; and,

WHEREAS, the location of the subject lease is as follows:

A part of Tract # 410 TF 147, that part of the Southwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 41, Range 17, Pine County, Minnesota, more particularly described as:

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; thence South 89 degrees 43 minutes 04 seconds East, assumed bearing, 360.00 feet along the south line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter to the point of the beginning of the tract of land to be described, thence North 0 degrees 16 minutes 56 seconds East 292.00 feet, thence North 68 degrees 58 minutes 30 seconds West 179.00 feet to the centerline of County Road No. 173, thence Southwesterly along said centerline to the South line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, thence South 89 degrees 43 minutes 04 seconds East 337.84 feet along said south line to the point of beginning. Subject to the right of way for County Road No. 173


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes the assignment of the Land Use Agreement issued to [REDACTED] by Resolution #07-04-11-98 to his father, [REDACTED] for the site described herein, with no other changes to the lease; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the lessee will utilize the land in conformity with the provisions of the lease within twelve (12) months of the effective date of the lease, and if all terms of the lease are not met, the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lessee abandon or vacate the above-described property for more than thirty (30) consecutive days after the 1st year anniversary of the effective date of the lease without the prior approval of the Band Assembly; and,


