RESOLUTION 08-04-12-00

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS IN A NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DRUG ABUSE (NIDA) FUNDED RESEARCH PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe was advised of the proposed NIDA funded project for a longitudinal study of 3rd 4th grade children and their parents among American Indians within the Mille Lacs Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe believes that the Band should pursue and participate in the proposed NIDA funded project; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe approves participation of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe in the proposed NIDA funded research project for American Indians.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Chief Executive hereunto recommend and affix my signature unto this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
