MINNESOTA, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, MENTAL
HEALTH DIVISION FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2000 AND 2001.**


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Administration and Commissioner of Health and Human Services are authorized to sign State grants, on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe support and wholeheartedly endorse the submission of a twoyear grant for Mental Health Services.
