RESOLUTION 09-04-118-01

A CONTINUING RESOLUTION FOR THE CONTINUATION OF ALL MILLE LACS BAND GOVERNMENT AND CORPORATE COMMISSION FISCAL OPERATIONS UNTIL OCTOBER 5, 2001.

WHEREAS,	the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the
	Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly passed Appropriation Bills 09-04-31-01 and 09-04-32-01on September 21, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive vetoed the Appropriation Bills on September 27, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive and the Band Assembly held a compromise hearing on September 28, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive and the Band Assembly were unable to reach an agreement on the concerns the Chief Executive brought before the Assembly on September 28, 2001;
- WHEREAS, 3 Mille Lacs Band Statutes Annotated section 18 states that in such circumstances the Band Assembly may adopt a continuing resolution to continue all fiscal operations of the Band.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of all Band and Corporate Commission fiscal operations until Friday, October 5 at 5:00 p.m.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of September 2001 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
