RESOLUTION 09-03-64-01

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 05-03-85-93 THAT
GRANTED A LEASE TO [REDACTED]**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-03-85-93, granted a lease to [REDACTED] and,

WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective February 19, 1993, for the property described herein; and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract 410 T 12

All in part of Northwest One-quarter (NW¼) of the Northwest One-quarter (NW¼) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Forty-three North (T43N) Range Twenty-seven West (R27W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota. Beginning at the SE corner of Allotment No. 12-A; meander along Spur Road north for a distance of 110.23 feet, thence East 290.05 feet, thence South 110.23 feet, thence West 290.23 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] is deceased; and,

WHEREAS, the lease document was never completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby rescinds Band Resolution 05-03-85-93 since [REDACTED] is deceased; and,



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land hereby reverts back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.


