RESOLUTION 09-03-51-01

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION # 21-80 FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution #21-80, authorized a lease to be given to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], and,

WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Township 43 North, Range 27 West, Northwest One-quarter (NW ¼) of the Northeast One-quarter (NE ¼) of Section 28, Lots 67 & 68, Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County.

WHEREAS, a Cancellation of Land Use Agreement for lease authorized by resolution #21-80, to [REDACTED] is being requested by [REDACTED] since their daughter, [REDACTED] was granted a lease of the site through Resolution # 77-84; and,


WHEREAS, [REDACTED] is currently leasing another site and [REDACTED] is deceased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Cancellation of Land Use Agreement for the lease authorized by Band Resolution #21-80; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.


