RESOLUTION 09-04-110-01

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS (BIA) TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has the right and responsibility to provide for the best interest of the Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 provides the authority for Tribes to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to provide services for their members; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has considerable experience in the provision of "638" contracts.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does hereby request of the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) the approval of a P.L. 93-638 contract to provide for road construction services for the Tribe; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) continue to provide engineering and project management assistance for the Mille Lacs Band road construction projects.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 25th of September 2001 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of _3_FOR, _0_AGAINST, _0_SILENT.
