RESOLUTION #09-03-31-01

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING TEMPORARY LAND USE
AGREEMENT DATED 12-7-64 FOR [REDACTED] AND
[REDACTED]**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, A Temporary Land Use Agreement, dated 12-7-64, authorized land use to [REDACTED] and,

WHEREAS, the unrecorded land use agreement was for a period of eight months with a specific legal description of the homesite, to be determined and attached hereto during construction or as soon as possible after completion,

WHEREAS, No resolution has been found to support the land use agreement;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Beginning at the center of the southeast quarter of Section 17, thence east 1307.3 feet, thence north 0 degrees 24 minutes west, a distance of 113.25 feet, thence north 61 degrees 49 minutes east, a distance of 1261.3 feet, thence north 78 degrees 54 minutes east, a distance of 164.9 feet, thence south 11 degrees 06 minutes east, a distance of 50 feet to point of beginning, thence south 11 degrees 06 minutes east, a distance of 200 feet, thence south 78 degrees 54 minutes east, a distance of 100 feet, thence north 11 degrees 06 minutes east, a distance of 200 feet, thence north 78 degrees 54 minutes east, a distance of 100 feet, to the point of beginning in Section 16, Township 143 N, Range 27 W.

WHEREAS, Cancellation requested by Lessor as a matter of record and due to expiration of term and non-use of the site. The site has been vacated for more than 30 days and a burned down structure is currently located on the site, and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] are residing under a lease at another site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby


