**RESOLUTION 09-04-115-01**

**A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL LEASE AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION  
#09-02-75-00 FOR [REDACTED]**

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,
- WHEREAS, Resolution #09-02-75-00, authorized a residential land lease to be given to [REDACTED] for the purpose of establishing his home; and,
- WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

A part of Tract # 410TF 83, Westwood Wellen Associates Certificate of Survey, Job # 20005622, dated 07-05-2000:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 42 North, Range 27 West, Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of Section 34; thence on an assumed bearing of South 88 degrees 38 minutes 07 seconds East, along the south line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 34, a distance of 1028.00 feet; thence North 01 degrees 21 minutes 53 seconds East of distance of 33.00 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continuing North 01 degrees 21 minutes 53 seconds East a distance of 200.00 feet; thence South 88 degrees 38 minutes 07 seconds East a distance of 200.00 feet; thence South 01 degrees 21 minutes 53 seconds West a distance of 200.00 feet; thence North 88 degrees 38 minutes 07 seconds West a distance of 200.00 feet to the point of beginning, approximately 40,000 square feet.

- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] will not be establishing a residence at the property described herein and has consented to cancellation of his lease due to non-use.



WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 25<sup>th</sup> of September, 2001 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
