**RESOLUTION 09-04-94-01**

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 05-02-37-93 FOR**  
[REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-02-37-93, authorized a lease to be given to [REDACTED] and,

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-02-37-93, lacked the Chief Executives signature and therefore a lease document was not completed; and,

WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective December 16<sup>th</sup> 1992, for the property described herein; and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 1, Twp 42 North, Range 25 West of the 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian described as follows:  
Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter; thence North 0 degrees 48', 58" East, bearing assumed along the East line of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter a distance of 33.00 feet; thence North 88 degrees 39', 30" West a distance of 1025.30 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continue North 88 degrees 39', 30" West a distance of 205.00 feet; thence North 0 degrees 19', 30" East a distance of 200.00 feet thence South 88 degrees 39' 30" East a distance of 205.00 feet; thence South 0 degrees 19', 30" West a distance of 200.00 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating.

WHEREAS, Cancellation of Resolution 05-02-37-93 is being requested by the Lessor due to lack of due process for the property described herein; and

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
WHEREAS, a new resolution is being drafted for [REDACTED] for the same location described herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Cancellation of Band Resolution #05-02-37-93; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 14th of August, 2001 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
