RESOLUTION 10-02-96-02

A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL A LEASE AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION 09-03-67-01 FOR

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home, and,
- WHEREAS, Resolution 09-03-67-01, authorized a lease to be given to the purpose of residential homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective October 3, 2001, for the property described herein; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract 410 T 1017 located in the Northeast one-quarter (NE ¼) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW ¼) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Forty-seven North (T47N), Range Twenty-three West (R23W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Aitkin County, Minnesota more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinate (478,897.27; 5,156,614.38) thence bearing in a southerly direction 196 feet to GPS coordinate (478,897.00; 5,156,554.63), thence bearing in a easterly direction 207 feet to GPS coordinate (478,960,.1; 5,156,555.79), thence bearing in a northerly direction to GPS coordinate (478,958.42; 5,156,615.75), thence bearing in a westerly direction GPS coordinate (478,897.27; 156,614.38), the point of beginning (GPS coordinates are Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) Zone 15 Nad 83 Projection Points). The lease site is approximately 1 acre more or less.

WHEREAS,	in voluntarily canceling his lease due to non-use.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Cancellation of the lease authorized by Band Resolution 09-03-67-01; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for lease to another Band member.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th of September, 2002 at Minnesota by a vote of 2_FOR, 0_AGAINST, 0_SILENT.
