## **RESOLUTION 10-02-100-02**

A CONTINUING RESOLUTION FOR THE CONTINUATION OF CORPORATE COMMISSION FISCAL YEAR OPERATIONS UNTIL OCTOBER 31, 2002

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, Band Assembly Appropriation Bill 09-04-31-01, to fund the operations of the Corporate Commission for fiscal year 2001-2002, will expire September 30, 2002; and
- WHEREAS, 3 Mille Lacs Band Statutes Annotated section 18 states that in such circumstances, when an appropriation bill will expire before the next such appropriation bill becomes law, the Band Assembly may adopt a continuing resolution to continue any of the Band's fiscal operations.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of all Corporate Commission fiscal operations until Thursday, October 31 at 5:00 p.m.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 26th day of September 2002 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of \_3\_FOR, \_0\_AGAINST, \_0\_SILENT.
