## **RESOLUTION 09-04-19-02**

## A RESOLUTION FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF CIRCLE OF HEALTH FISCAL OPERATIONS UNTIL JANUARY 31, 2002

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly passed appropriation bills 09-04-31-01 and 09-04-32-01 on September 21, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive vetoed the appropriation bills on September 27, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive and the Band Assembly held a compromise hearing on September 28 and October 2, 2001, and agreed that a separate appropriation bill for Circle of Health would be prepared; and
- WHEREAS, MLBSA § 18 states that in such circumstances the Band Assembly may adopt a continuing resolution to continue all fiscal operations of the Band.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of all Circle of Health operations until Thursday, January 31, 2001 at 5:00 p.m.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 3rd of January, 2002 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
