## **RESOLUTION 10-02-89-02**

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 09-02-98-00 TO REFLECT NAME CHANGE FROM "MILLE LACS HOME ONE" TO "20 HOME PROJECT".

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home, and;
- WHEREAS, Resolution 09-02-76-00 amended by Resolution 09-02-98-00 authorized a land lease to Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority, to the subject property for the purpose of the "Mille Lacs Home One" project; and,
- WHEREAS, the project shall now and in the future be referred to as the "20 home project"; and the lease information and description in Resolution 09-02-98-00 shall remain the same; and will be for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, subject to the lease provisions.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes the name change from "Mille Lacs Home One" to "20 Home Project".
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 18th day of July, 2002 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
