JOINT-RESOLUTION 09-04-08-02

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFER OF ENROLLMENT TO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FROM LAC COURTE OREILLES BAND OF CHIPPEWA IN WISCONSIN.**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following application for transfer from the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Chippewa in Wisconsin to Mille Lacs; and,

WHEREAS, the following individual is eligible due to their blood quantum and their ancestral background:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly accepts the above individual for enrollment and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required transfer.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 16th day of October, 2001 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for Concurrence.


