JOINT-RESOLUTION 09-04-10-02

A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFERS OF ENROLLMENT TO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FROM THE RED LAKE BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following applications for transfer from the Red Lake Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the following individuals are eligible due to their blood quantum and their ancestral background:

Red Lake: Skinaway, Elizabeth Anne d.o.b. [REDACTED]  
Skinaway, Sandra Marie d.o.b. [REDACTED]

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly accepts the above individuals for enrollment and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required transfers.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 16th day of October, 2001 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
