RESOLUTION 10-02-10-03

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A TWO-HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$250,000) GRANT TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN, FAMILIES AND LEARNING TO PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATIONAL AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the improvement of social and economic conditions and quality of life for Band members is a priority of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that one of its most pressing priorities is providing quality education and educational services for all youth and Band members; and
- WHEREAS, a goal of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is to develop a multi-faceted program to provide comprehensive educational and mental health support services to youth who are not well connected to school and historically have been difficult to serve through traditional school programs and services; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota has authorized grants to school systems through Project Reconnect for the purpose of getting troubled youth reconnected with school; and
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize the joint submission of a grant by the Mille Lacs Band Commissioner of Education and the Commissioner of Health and Human Services to the Minnesota Department of Children, Families and Learning for the purpose of developing and implementing Project Reconnect.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 30th day of October 2002 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
