JOINT RESOLUTION 10-04-67-03

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA AMERICAN INDIAN NURSES I.H.S. P.L. 94-437 SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT PROPOSAL.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service requires a resolution from the Mille Lacs Tribal government supporting the submission of the proposal; and
- WHEREAS, the University of Minnesota School of Nursing has submitted a proposal to the Indian Health Service for recruitment, retention and support for Indian nurses; and
- the I.H.S. scholarship will provide funding for 5 American Indian nurses to enter and WHEREAS. graduate from the University of Minnesota with a degree in nursing; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is in need of ongoing nursing professionals to staff their clinic(s); and
- the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe would be pleased to place nursing students and/or WHEREAS, graduates as needed in their clinic(s); and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby supports the submission of the American Indian Nursing Scholarship proposal by Dr. Felicia Hodge of the University of Minnesota School of Nursing.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 21st day of July, 2003 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
