JOINT RESOLUTION 10-02-02-03

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT TO THE MEDTRONIC FOUNDATION HEARTS RESCUE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,000 TO PURCHASE FOUR PORTABLE CARDIAC DEFIBRILLATORS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that providing quality health care and emergency medical services for all Band members is one of the most pressing priorities; and
- WHEREAS, many of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe members reside in geographically isolated rural areas with immediate emergency medical services in some cases up to 90 miles away.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Medtronic Foundation Hearts Rescue Grant Program to equip the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Tribal Police Department in each of the three outlying reservation districts with life saving emergency portable defibrillators.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th day of October 2002 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
