## **RESOLUTION 10-02-20-03**

## A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO CREATE AN EARLY EDUCATION/CHILD CARE CENTER IN DISTRICT I

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2 empowers the Band Assembly with the authority and duty to enact laws to regulate internal and external affairs to promote the general welfare of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2(d) authorizes the Band Assembly to adopt resolutions to conduct such business of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has determined that a need exists to authorize a general feasibility study to determine whether an Early Education/Child Care Center in District I is needed and to assess the costs associated with the same; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes that a feasibility study be prepared for review to assist in determining whether an Early Education/Child Care Center in District I is needed and to assess the financial impacts of the same.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 7th day of January 2003 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
