JOINT-RESOLUTION 11-01-50-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENROLLMENTS INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FOR THOSE WHO MEET THE ¼ DEGREE REQUIREMENTS OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE. (New Ordinance)

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the following application; and,



do meet the requirements for enrollment into the Mille Lacs Band, based on the new Enrollment Ordinance, Section III. G.


