JOINT RESOLUTION 10-04-05-04

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RELINQUISHMENT FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION TO THE ST. CROIX RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following application for relinquishment from the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, Jeremy Alex Cash [REDACTED]

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that this individual does meet the requirements for membership with the St. Croix Reservation and does approve the granting of the relinquishment for the above individual.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 14th day of October, 2003 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
