### RESOLUTION 11-02-94-04

#### **A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION #11-01-51-04 WHICH AUTHORIZED A LAND LEASE FOR [REDACTED]**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution #11-01-51-04, authorized a land lease to [REDACTED] for the purpose of a homesite; and,

WHEREAS, the lease was for a period of 30 years and renewable for an additional 20 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective April 20, 2004 for the property described herein; and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract # 410 T 1030, described as Government Lots Six (6) and Seven (7) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Forty-three North (T43N), Range Twenty-seven West (R27W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

Lot One (1), "D" Street Plat.

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has been approved for financing from the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe (MCT) for the purpose of a home loan for a house located on the lease description above; and,


WHEREAS, [REDACTED] no longer wishes to lease Lot One (1) of "D" Street Plat and no longer wishes to obtain her financing with MCT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves rescinding Band Resolution #11-01-51-04 which authorized a lease with an attached mortgage to [REDACTED] at the property described herein; and,

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that the land described herein will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for lease to another Band member.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 3rd day of August, 2004 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
