JOINT RESOLUTION 11-02-99-04

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PLACE LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have acquired lands, some within the exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation for housing, agricultural and public purposes; and,

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to have these lands transferred to the United States of America in Trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be transferred to the United States of America in Trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians;

Tract # 410 TF 108, described as follows:


Real Property located in the North one-half (N ½) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW ¼) of Section Twenty (20), Township Forty-three North (T43N), Range Twenty-seven West (R27W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota; and,

Tract # 410 TF 193, described as follows:

Real Property described as the East one-half (E ½) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW ¼), the North one-half (N ½) of the Southeast one-quarter (SE ¼), and the Northeast one-quarter (NE ¼), all in section Nineteen (19), Township Forty-three North (T43N), Range Twenty-seven West (R27W) Fourth Principal Meridian, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, EXCEPT the North 650.00 feet of the East 403.00 feet of the Northeast one-quarter (NE ¼) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Forty-three North (T43N).


WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 16th of August, 2004 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
