RESOLUTION 10-04-83-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF ATRIBAL MANAGEMENT GRANT TO THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC PLAN, IMPROVE INTERNAL AND EXTENAL WORKING RELATIONSHIP, AND INCREASE THIRD PARTY REVENUES

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that providing quality health care services for all Band members is one of its most pressing priorities; and
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Department of Health and Human Services is to provide comprehensive, quality care and services to members of the Mille Lacs Band and other federally recognized Tribes in a culturally sensitive manner and in keeping with the individual's right to self-determination.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Indian Health Service to develop a strategic plan, improve internal and external working relationships, and increase third party revenues.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of July 2004 at Isle, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0, AGAINST, 0, SILENT
