RESOLUTION 11-02-98-04

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF THE
TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF
OJIBWE TO THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS (BIA)**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2 empowers the Band Assembly with the authority and duty to enact laws to regulate internal and external affairs to promote the general welfare of the Band; and

WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 2(d) authorizes the Band Assembly to adopt resolutions to conduct such business of the Band; and

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has determined that a need exists and supports a Transportation Plan for District I, District II and District III; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby supports a Transportation Plan be submitted for review to assist in determining the need and to assess the financial impacts of the same.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 5th day of August 2004 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
