RESOLUTION 11-01-73-04

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS DEMOLISH BUILDING 101, OLD SCHOOL, LOCATED ON TRACT 410T1007.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,
- the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee authorized a lease through WHEREAS, Resolution 12-86 for the Community Center to be constructed for school and community activities; and,
- WHEREAS, the Community Center is located on approximately 10 acres more or less in the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) all in Tract # 410 TF 1007 described as the South one-half of the Northwest one-quarter (S 1/2 NW 1/4) of section Twenty-eight (28) Township Forty-seven North (T47N), Range Twenty-seven West (R27W) Fourth Principal Meridian; and,
- WHEREAS, the Community Center is currently known as Building 101, Old School on the Bureau of Indian affairs inventory; and,
- the Community Center structure is no longer a viable building and posses a health WHEREAS. and safety risk to the community; and,
- WHEREAS. The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to have the Bureau of Indian Affairs demolish the Community Center.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to demolish and remove the Old Community Center, which is the property of the Bureau of Indian Affairs located on the property described above.
