RESOLUTION 11-01-82-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN INDIAN HEALTH SERVICES SPECIAL DIABETES FOR INDIANS COMPETITIVE GRANTS PROGRAM FOR THE PREVENTION OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE IN PEOPLE WITH DIABETES

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established as a priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality life for the people of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that providing quality health care WHEREAS. services for all Band members is one of it most pressing priorities; and
- the goal of the Department of Health and Human Services is to provide WHEREAS, comprehensive, quality care and clinical diabetes services to members of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe and other federal-recognized tribal peoples in a culturally sensitive manner and in keeping with the individuals right to selfdetermination; and
- the Department of Health and Human Services will collaborate with the St. Croix WHEREAS. Band of Chippewa Indians in actively competing for the Special Diabetes Program for Indians Demonstration Project for Prevention of Cardiovascular Disease in People with Diabetes; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the submission of a grant to the Indian Health Services Special Diabetes Program for Indians Competitive Grant Program.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of July 2004 at Isle, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
