JOINT RESOLUTION 11-01-79-04

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BLOOD QUANTUM INCREASE, BASED ON NEW ENROLLMENT ORDINANCE, SECTION VII.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee has adopted a new Enrollment Ordinance by Resolution No. 116-03, passed July 30, 2003 at a regular meeting of the Tribal Executive Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the following documentations, and based on the new Enrollment Ordinance, section VII the blood quantum of:

WHEREAS, the attached is a copy of the base roll for the Day family, showing the blood quantum as [redacted] for [redacted] but [redacted] died in 1920 prior to the 1941 base roll. A Copy of the White Earth Full Blood Allottee List #50 lists [redacted] and [redacted] as full bloods. The enrollment cards and the family sheets are also attached. All of the above siblings have the same parents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves the above individuals blood quantum increases, based on the new Enrollment Ordinance, Section VII.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th, day of July 2004 at Isle, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
