## **RESOLUTION 11-01-67-04**

## A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION #11-01-44-04 WHICH AUTHORIZED A LAND LEASE FOR

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,
- WHEREAS, Resolution #11-01-44-04, authorized a land lease to for the purpose of a homesite; and,
- the lease was for a period of 25 years and renewable for an additional 25 years, WHEREAS, subject to the lease provisions, effective March 23, 2004 for the property described herein; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Part of Tract 410 T 1002 located in the North one-half (N ½) of the Northeast One-quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Forty-three North (T43N) Range Twenty-seven West (R27W) Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, Fourth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Lot Eight (8), Block Four (4), Vineland Hills Plat dated March 9, 1992, by Anthony E. Kerrick registered surveyor #12266; and,

- WHEREAS. has been approved for financing from the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Housing Department for the purpose of a home loan for a house located in the Bugg Hill Deveopment; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves rescinding Band Resolution #11-01-44-04 which authorized a lease to at the property described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that the land described herein will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for lease to another Band member. Resolution 11-01-67-04 Page 2

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 16th day of June, 2004 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
