RESOLUTION 11-01-34-04

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHIEF EXECUTIVE MELANIE BENJAMIN TO SIGN THE PINE COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and.
- WHEREAS, a priority of the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is to provide for the welfare of the eligible and enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA sec. 2(f) Band Assembly has authority to ratify agreements, contracts, cooperative and reciprocity agreements and memoranda of understanding.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly hereby authorizes the Chief Executive to sign the Pine County Law Enforcement Agreement.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted by a quorum of legislators being present held on the <u>3rd</u> day of February, 2004 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of <u>3</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
