## **JOINT-RESOLUTION 11-03-47-05**

## A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TITLE VI – ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Administration on Aging has financial resources available to provide social and nutritional services to the Elderly, and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians has a desire to continue participating in the Nutrition Program for the Elderly, and
- WHEREAS, this is a 3-year project starting April 1, 2005 to March 31, 2008.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians has prepared an application and proposal for continued funding for the Title VI Nutrition Program for the Elderly pursuant to the regulation requirement of the program.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 19th, day of January, 2005 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 2\_FOR, <u>O\_AGAINST,O\_SILENT</u>.
