## RESOLUTION 11-02-10-05


### **A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION #11-02-88-04 AUTHORIZING A LAND LEASE FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES AND ACQUIRING FINANCING THROUGH THE HOUSING INITIATIVE HOME LOAN PROGRAM TO [REDACTED]**

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and,
- WHEREAS, Resolution #011-02-88-04, authorized a land lease for residential purposes to be given to [REDACTED] for establishing his home with financing obtained from the Housing Initiative Home Loan Program; and,
- WHEREAS, the lease was to be for a period of 30 years and renewable for an additional 20 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:
- Part of Tract # 410 TF 138, located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE ¼ of NE ¼) of Section Four (4), Township Forty-one North (T41N), Range Seventeen West (R17W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Pine County, Minnesota described as follows:
- Lot Two (2), Block Four (4) Wilderness Estates 1<sup>st</sup> Addition; and,
- WHEREAS, rescinding Resolution #11-02-88-04 is being requested by the Lessee due to non-use; and
- WHEREAS, a signed document by the Lessee requesting rescinding Resolution # 11-02-88-04 is attached as exhibit B as a part of this resolution; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the Rescinding of Band Resolution #11-02-88-04; and,

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 19th of October, 2004 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
