A JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENROLLMENT INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND, BASED ON NEW ENROLLMENT ORDINANCE, SECTION III, G.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following application for enrollment; and


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the application to reconsider the blood quantum for:


