## **JOINT RESOLUTION 11-02-43-05**

A JOINT RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE APPOINTMENT OF SAM GURNOE TO THE MINNESOTA INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council requires a resolution from the Mille Lacs Tribal government supporting the appointment of their Tribal representative to the council; and
- WHEREAS, each Tribe in Minnesota has a seat on the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Board; and
- WHEREAS, Sam Gurnoe is employed as the Director of Family Services for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
- NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians wholeheartedly supports and endorses Sam Gurnoe as a member of the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 4th day of January, 2005 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
