RESOLUTION 11-03-92-05

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE NAY AH SHING SCHOOL REMODEL USING THE BIA P.L. 100-297 GRANT AND BAND APPROPRIATED FUNDS

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established the priority to improve the social and economic conditions and quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation in its entirety; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly recognizes that education and opportunities for education for the Mille Lacs Band children are the means to advance the social and economic conditions for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe established the Nay Ah Shing School in 1974 with federal funding from the Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide education programs for the Mille Lacs Band children that are consistent with the Mille Lacs traditional and cultural values; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is committed to providing culturally-appropriate educational programs that are held in an accessible, safe, and secure environment.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve of the action of the Commissioner of Education and the Nay Ah Shing School Board to enter into a P.L. 100-297 Facilities Improvement and Repair construction grant amendment to repair items listed in the BIA furnished Program of Requirements and to construct an additional gym storage room (see Addendum "A").
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize and approve the action of the Commissioner of Education to seek additional appropriations for additional work needed to the schools beyond the P.L. 100-297 grant (see Addendum "B").
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th of June, 2005 at Onamia, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
