RESOLUTION 12-01-67-06

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUANCE OF GAMING REGULATORY AUTHORITY FISCAL OPERATIONS UNTIL MARCH 31, 2006

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has the authority to appropriate all Band revenue, regardless of source; and
- WHEREAS, 3 MLBSA § 18 states that all fiscal operations under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band shall cease as of midnight of the last day of the fiscal year unless the Band Assembly adopts a continuing resolution prior to such time.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the continuance of Gaming Regulatory Authority fiscal operations until March 31, 2006.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 26th day of January, 2006 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of _3_FOR,_0_AGAINST,_0_SILENT.
