RESOLUTION 11-04-18-06

A RESOLUTION MODIFYING RESOLUTION #11-02-36-05 WHICH AUTHORIZED A RESIDENTIAL LAND LEASE WITH AN ATTACHED MORTGAGE FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for agricultural purposes, to establish a home-site or a seasonal recreational residence, and for any commercial activity, or to acquire financing for a home; and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] respectfully requests a land lease with an attached mortgage for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has been approved for financing from the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians Housing Department for the purpose of a home located on the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the lease will be for a period of 35 years and renewable for an additional 15 years, subject to the lease provisions, effective upon date of approval, for the property described herein; and

WHEREAS, the legal description was erroneously described as follows:

Part of Tract #410 TF 46, located in the South one-half of the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North one-half of the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Forty-four North (T44N) Range Twenty-five West (R25W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Aitkin County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at a Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinate (461,815.36; 5,127,428.12) thence bearing North 0 degrees 51 minutes 03 seconds East a distance of 223.91 feet; thence North 89 degrees 05 minutes 09 seconds West a distance of 208.39 feet; thence South 02 degrees 30 minutes 06 seconds East a distance of 228.54 feet; thence North 89 degrees 40 minutes 28 seconds East a distance of 195.07 feet to GPS coordinate (461,815.36; 127,428.12), the point of

WHEREAS, The correct legal description should be as follows:

Part of Tract #410 TF 46, located in the South one-half of the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North one-half of the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Forty-four North (T44N) Range Twenty-five West (R25W), Fourth Principal Meridian, Aitkin County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at a Global Position System (GPS) coordinate (461866.51 5127444.72) thence bearing north 0 degrees 51 minutes 03 seconds east a distance of 223.91 feet; thence north 89 degrees 05 minutes 09 seconds west a distance of 208.39 feet; thence south 2 degrees 30 minutes 06 seconds east a distance of 228.54 feet; thence north 89 degrees 40 minutes 28 seconds east a distance of 195.07 feet to GPS coordinate (461866.51; 5127444.72) the point of beginning (GPS coordinates are Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) Zone 15 NAD 83 Projection Points). The lease site is approximately 1 acre more or less.

WHEREAS, The lease rental is \$1.00 and there is a \$2.00 lease processing fee.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes modification of Resolution #11-02-36-05 by changing the legal description and all terms and conditions shall remain the same; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the lessee will utilize the land in conformity with the provisions of the lease within twelve (12) months of the effective date of the lease, and if all terms of the lease are not met, the land will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lessee abandon or vacate the above-described property for more than thirty (30) consecutive days after the 1st year anniversary of the effective date of the lease without the prior approval of the Band Assembly; and

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th of November, 2005 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
