JOINT RESOLUTION 11-03-91-05

A JOINT RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE POSITION IN REGARD TO ITS STANCE OF NON-INTERFERENCE IN ANY OTHER TRIBE'S OR OTHER OJIBWE BAND'S GOVERNMENTAL BUSINESS UNLESS CONDUCTED AS PART OF OFFICIAL MCT BUSINESS

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive of the Band is empowered to exercise the executive branch powers of the Band; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and Chief Executive acknowledge that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has elected to take a firm stand to not assume a formal position in regard to any other tribe's or Band's governmental business unless as part of official Minnesota Chippewa Tribe (MCT) business.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby take a firm stand of non-interference into any other tribe's or Band's governmental business unless it is part of official Minnesota Chippewa Tribe (MCT) business.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th of November, 2005 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of _3_FOR, _0_AGAINST, _0_SILENT.
